

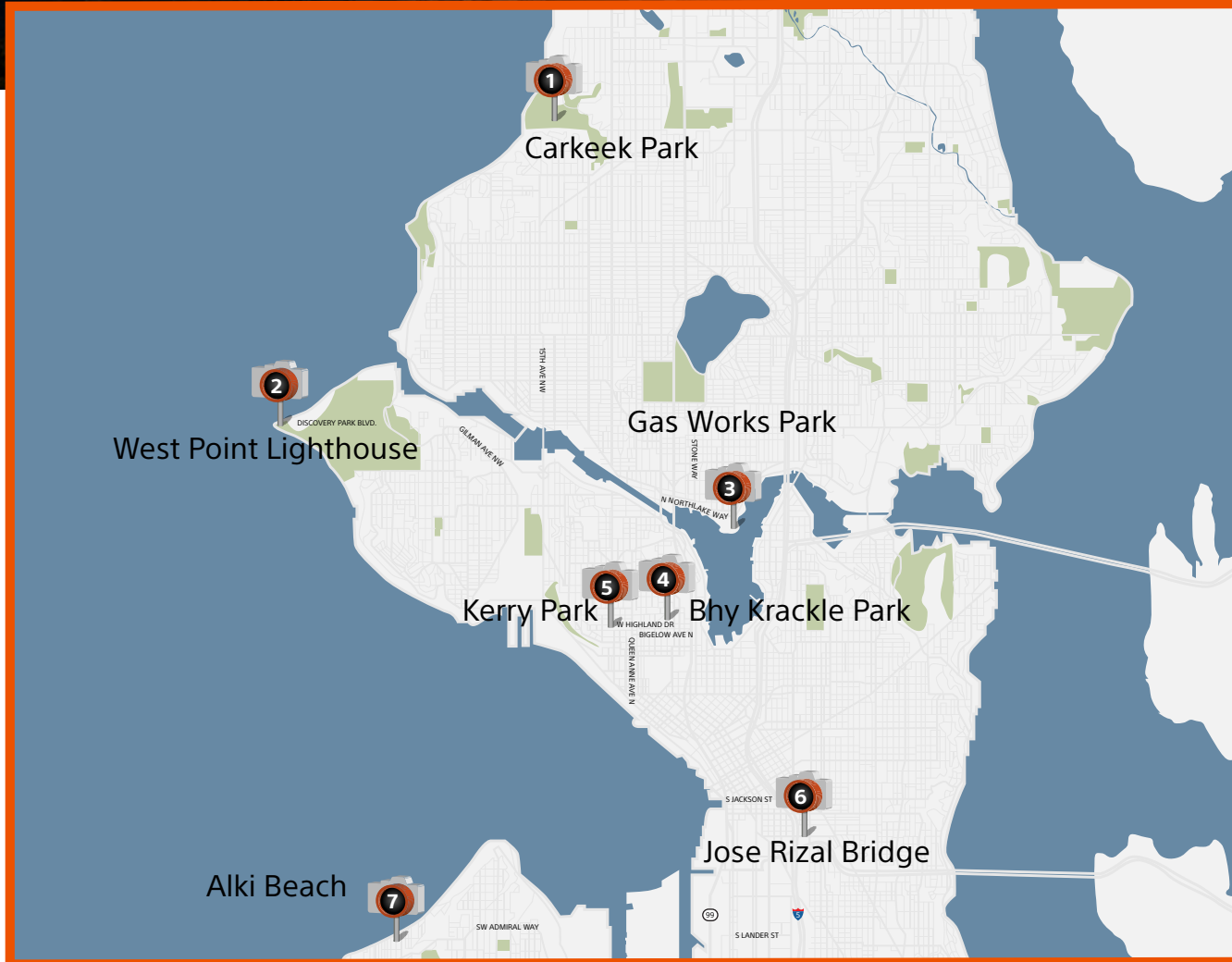

- 1 Carkeek Park**
Fantastic water views and if you time it just right, you can sometimes catch a cargo train as it hugs its way down the coastline.
- 2 West Point Lighthouse**
Located right in the heart of Seattle in Discovery Park - the West Point Lighthouse is worthy of a visit anytime of year.
- 3 Gas Works Park**
Along the north shore of Lake Union - take the short climb up to Kite Hill for some great shots.
- 4 Bhy Krackle Park**
A hidden gem, not as well known as Kerry Park but beautiful foliage in the late fall and early winter, with fantastic views of the Space Needle.
- 5 Kerry Park**
Best location for the classic view of Seattle - you get the Space Needle, the skyline and Mt. Rainier.
- 6 Jose Rizal Bridge**
Just south of the International District, another great spot for amazing views of the Emerald City.
- 7 Alki Beach**
A must-see if you are in Seattle with superb views - if you venture on to the western point, you will see the Alki Point Lighthouse.
